

Work Plan and Budget for Implementation of Firstmile Phase II: Year 1.

First Year: June 2007 – May 2008

The first year of the First Mile project, after appropriate preparation and planning of the technical assistance, starts with a survey to underpin the development of appropriate trials on ICT connectivity in selected AMSDP districts. Trials will determine the profitability of various connectivity options in select districts. At the same time IDESO will develop a prototype programme that shall allow farmers and traders to use SMS to access an online database at the District level with updated locally relevant market intelligence and market information. Further local learning in this year will focus on: a) the extent to which key players along the marketing chains are capable of using the ICTs for generating and exchanging locally relevant market intelligence; and b) the determination of the technical support requirements for local Market Access Companies to sustain their connectivity with client farmers and market intermediaries. Good practices and model business plans emerging from the ICT trials will be packaged for sharing with other districts.

Activities and Schedule

1. Preparation, planning and reporting for the project

Organize and plan the required interactions between relevant Divisions in IFAD and Agridea and IDESO in Switzerland who are involved in the project. Develop detailed work plans for integration of technical assistance activities of Agridea with IFAD Communications Division activities. Prepare progress report for the first year. Update and maintain First Mile project website including all documented outputs of the activities in the first year. Manage and update the LLL service First Mile learning team including membership and contact details. Reporting also includes participation in one of IFAD's internal learning events.

2. Trials on ICT connectivity to small farmers and market intermediaries

Develop and conduct a survey in five target districts (Hai, Babati, Muheza, Mufindi, Songea) that determines: a) what is the current status of connectivity in the District? and, b) which technology options for connectivity to follow in the District over the next 2-3 years? Analyze data to identify the appropriate connectivity options for each District and prepare a report on the survey. Design a trials programme with each of the five target districts to test connectivity options. Mentor the implementation of the trials on the development of sustained 'commercial' operation of ICT connectivity. Collect data for building model business plans for renting out ICT equipment to client farmer groups and market intermediaries. Follow up and assess the results of the trials. Prepare the findings of the trials in a format of good practices that can be used by AMSDP staff to scale up the commercialization of ICT connectivity in other districts covered by the programme.

3. Local learning on generating and exchanging locally relevant market intelligence

Design, in collaboration with AMSDP, a local learning programme for Market Access Companies to implement in selected districts that will enable the key players along the marketing chains to identify the local market intelligence information that is relevant to them and from which they can benefit. Follow up and assess the results of the local learning programme. Develop interfaces to facilitate mobile-to-internet data exchange. Design a program interface that allows local market 'info-mediaries' to upload relevant local market intelligence using sms to an online database and allows clients to download it using sms messages from their mobiles. The interface should also allow for farmers to make deals over mobiles with other key players in the market chain using sms messaging.

4. Local learning on technical support requirements for Market Access Companies

Set up and mentor a local learning programme for AMSDP central and zonal staff to explore and define the technical support requirements for local Market Access Companies to sustain their connectivity with client farmers and market intermediaries. Implementation of the local learning will include: a) face-to-face get-togethers of MAC operators, b) running the online platform on which MACs are sharing experiences, and c) exploring business opportunities to sustain connectivity for the MACs. Follow up and assess the results of the local learning programme.
